

About cookies

1. The FTM Brokers Limited Liability Company cookie policy (hereinafter we) explains how we use cookies and what controls you have over their use.
2. When browsing the ftm.by website any page your computer (device) downloads the page itself, as well as a small text file called cookie. Many sites use cookies because they allow them to do many useful things. For example, they allow website owners to determine whether a particular computer (and probably its user) has visited the site before. This is done during a second visit to the site by checking the user's computer (device) for a cookie left over from a previous visit.
3. The information we collect through cookies helps us to provide you with our services in a way that is most useful to you and can help us to understand our users. We use cookies if you use our website (whether or not you are registered and logged in).
4. We use the Google Analytics to collect and analyse statistical data: Google on our behalf collects non-personal information about the ftm.by visitors, using cookies; the website visits records and special code placed on our website. 5. A cookie is data, often including a unique, anonymous identifier, sent to your browser by a website, which is stored on your computer's hard drive. Each site can send its own cookies to your computer if your browser settings allow it. To protect your privacy, your browser only allows websites to access their own cookies. Often a cookie is sent as soon as the user visits the site: this is how the visits number to the site is counted.
6. Users can set their computers (devices) to automatically accept all cookies, or to be warned each time a website tries to write its own cookie to the user's hard drive, or not to accept any cookies at all. The latter option means that some personal services cannot be provided to the users, and that the users who choose such settings will not be able to use the ftm.by.
7. When you provide any personal information to ftm.by (for example, to subscribe to ftm.by newsletter) the way in which we use that applicable law governs information.

Generally, only we and our representatives or service providers use any information you provide. We will only disclose your information where required or permitted by law. We will retain your personal information on our system for as long as necessary to ensure the relevant service smooth operation or as required or permitted by law.
